# The First Open Swedish National Championships in Indoor Wingsuit Flying 2018

The Indoor Wingsuiting Club Stockholm, in cooperation with the Swedish Parachute Association, the Swedish Air Sport Federation and Indoor Wingsuit Stockholm™ invites you to the first Open Swedish National Championships in Indoor Wingsuit Flying. The competition is categorised as Open, which means that nations other than Sweden may participate.

## Aim

To establish and develop competitions in indoor wingsuit flying.

To select the national champions and set records in indoor wingsuit flying.

To exchange experiences and strengthen the friendship between wingsuit flyers in Sweden and other nations, as well as to disseminate information about indoor wingsuit flying.

## About the Inclined Wind Tunnel

Indoor Wingsuit Stockholm™ is the world's first inclined wind tunnel for sports such as indoor wingsuit flying. The competition will take place in the flight chamber's glass enclosure and will be easily seen by spectators from soundproofed stands. Areas for television and other media will be reserved at all levels in the building.

## Competition Disciplines

The competition will be in *Acrobatic Wingsuit Flying* in accordance with Competition Rules specifically written for this event and which are based on and adapted from the 2018 IPC Competition Rules for Wingsuit Flying. Each team has 2 members. An English copy of the Rules is available through the Swedish Parachute Association webpage: <http://www.sff.se>

## Competition Terms

Competitors must hold a valid indoor wingsuit Flight Certificate and be approved for all flying maneuvers in the competition pool, and have approved equipment (see below). For certification and approval by an indoor wingsuit Flight Master, contact: [info@inclined.se](mailto:info@inclined.se). All clubs and nations can participate with teams in the competition. For the competition to be conducted, at least two teams must participate. Medals are awarded in accordance with the Swedish Air Sport Federation General Competition Rules.

## Registration

Registration must be made to the competition organization via email (see below) together with payment of the competition fee. The registration and the competition fee must be in the hands of the competition organization no later than **Saturday, November 24, 2018**.

The registration fee includes three minutes of fly-in training time per team plus competition flying time 7 x 90 seconds (SEK 500 / participant) and competition costs (SEK 700 / participant ) . Loan of a wingsuit, a full face helmet and back protection are included free of charge. Costs for travel, accommodation and transportation to / from the competition are not included in the registration fee. The official notification is binding. The competition fee is refundable according to FAI Sporting Code Section 5, Chapter 4.4.5.

## Equipment

Wingsuit, full face helmet and back protection are mandatory equipment and can be borrowed free of charge on site. Participants may use their own personal equipment, but it must be formally approved by the organization, including a check-in flight not included in the registration fee.

## Protest Fee

SEK 500 to be refunded if accepted. If rejected given to the the Swedish Parachute Association competition fund.

Check-in and fly-in training 8.00-11.00

Sequence selection, flying order and team briefing 11:00

The competition begins at 12:00 and ends at 16:00

Closing ceremony with award recognition will take place no later than one hour after the completion of the competition.
